

Germany: Tübingen University

The Universität Tübingen, in Baden Württemberg, exchanges students with Reed for a semester or academic year. Founded in medieval times, Tübingen is recognized for its humanities faculties, particularly in philosophy.

Qualifications: Sophomore standing and at least 2 years of college-level German or equivalent as determined by German Literature Department.

Term duration: Year or Semester

Typical course load: 3-4 courses /semester

Courses recorded in: Hours/Week

Translates to Reed units: Typically 2 or 3 hours/week
2 Hrs = 0.75 Reed Units
3 Hrs = 1.00 Reed Units
140 Hr Language & Orientation = 2.00 Units

Grading system: 1 to 6

Translates to Reed grades*: 1.0 to 2.5 = A
2.6 to 3.5 = B
3.6 to 4.0 = C
4.1 to 6.0 = F
